

Yanta White Suffolks met strong demand with a total clearance of the 77 rams offered, however the Poll Merinos lacked buyer support, only selling 25 of the 38 offered. The top price White Suffolk 190178 was bought by the Karulga stud from Ungarra for \$3000. His balance of performance figures and conformation with PWT 19.9, PFAT -0.7, PEMD 2.3 and a TCP of 156, impressed owner Grantley Telfer.

Drinawal Pastoral bought 6 rams ,averaging \$1833, including 2nd top priced ram with PWT 19.3 and TCP 150, for \$2400.

First time White Suffolk buyer, Julian Webb, purchased 3 rams averaging \$1333, including a Woolumbool 173980 son with TCP 152 for \$1800.

Volume buyers of White Suffolks were Telunga Enterprises, purchasing 11 rams averaging \$927, and Westwind Wudinna buying 10 rams at an average of \$900. Many rams featured ASBV's and TCP index in the top 5 or 10%.

Stud principal, Don Baillie, believed he had his strongest ever line-up of Poll Merinos, featuring some April drops for the first time. They averaged 116 kg in body weight, with the July/August drop averaging 99 kg and a 17.1 average micron. Top priced ram was bought by Mark Noonan of Hornsdale for \$2200, a Leahcim 152775 son with a YWT ASBV of 9.2. He also bought a Collinsville Regent 242 grandson with a CFW 25 and DP+ index of 174 for \$1800.

PG & FAB Carey from Minnipa bought 6 rams, as did Timkin Prop. From Tumby Bay. Other prominent buyers were JC & TL Webb, TN & RA Richardson and Glen Avon Trust. Tag 190101 bred from Mernowie 170432 appealed to Taris Richardson, with YWT 8.1, YCFW 25 and body weight of 126 kg.
